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THINGS TO KNOW

This section is fundamental to obtain structured information on the current use of specific Recognition and Qualification frameworks and on the perceived importance of harmonisation activity at an EU level.

The activity has been undertaken with reference to 5 key qualification frameworks listed in the questionnaires (VDA-QMC, ECQA, TUV, SUD, BUREAU VERITAS, IATF) and a "other" available option.

HIGHLIGHTS

"ECQA" is the most frequently recognised by providers (respondents to the Offer survey) but the least recognised by respondents to the Demand survey.

"VDA-QMC" is widely accepted (and "IATF") by Demand survey respondents but recognition is negligible in relation to the Offer survey respondents.

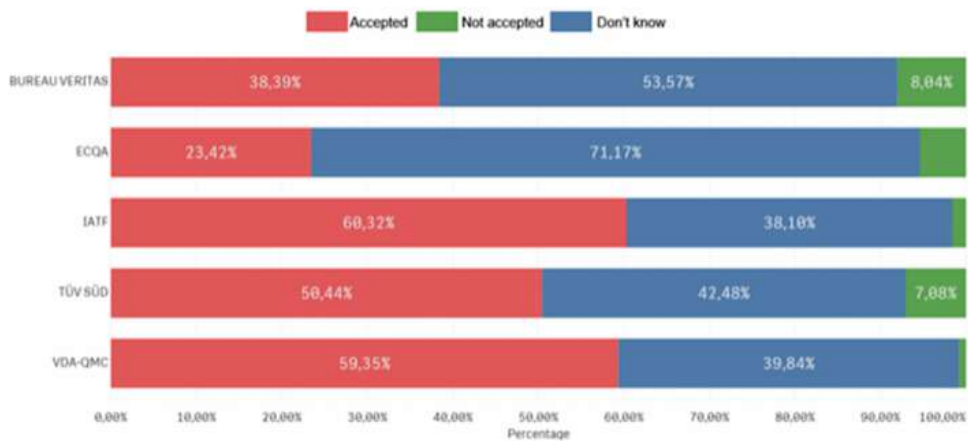
Of particular note is the importance attached to "NATIONAL" standards by VET stakeholders (to better investigate if "national" means <<only valid / recognised in a specific country>>)



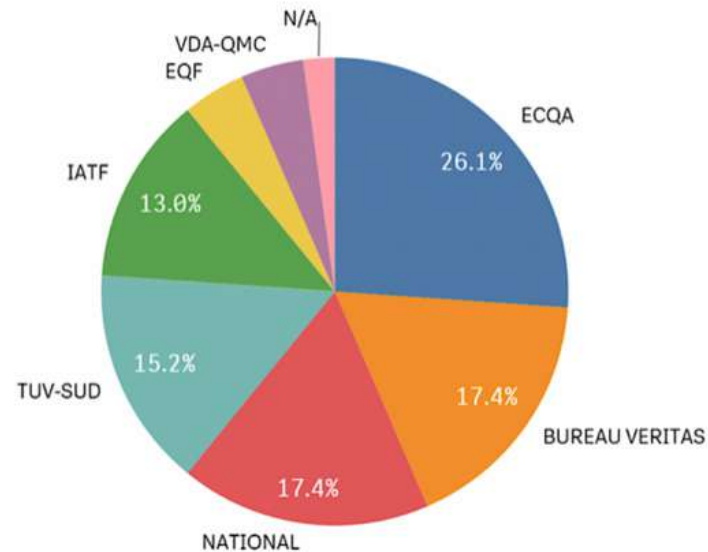
