## THINGS TO KNOW

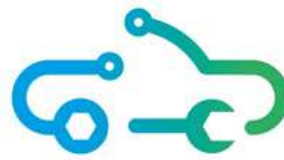
- The way to enable and ease movement of skilled workers in EU countries is by establishing standards.
- Automotive stakeholders identified and assessed the most recognised standard and qualification frameworks.
- Sectoral associations underline the importance of understanding the differences amongst different stakeholder groups.

## HIGHLIGHTS

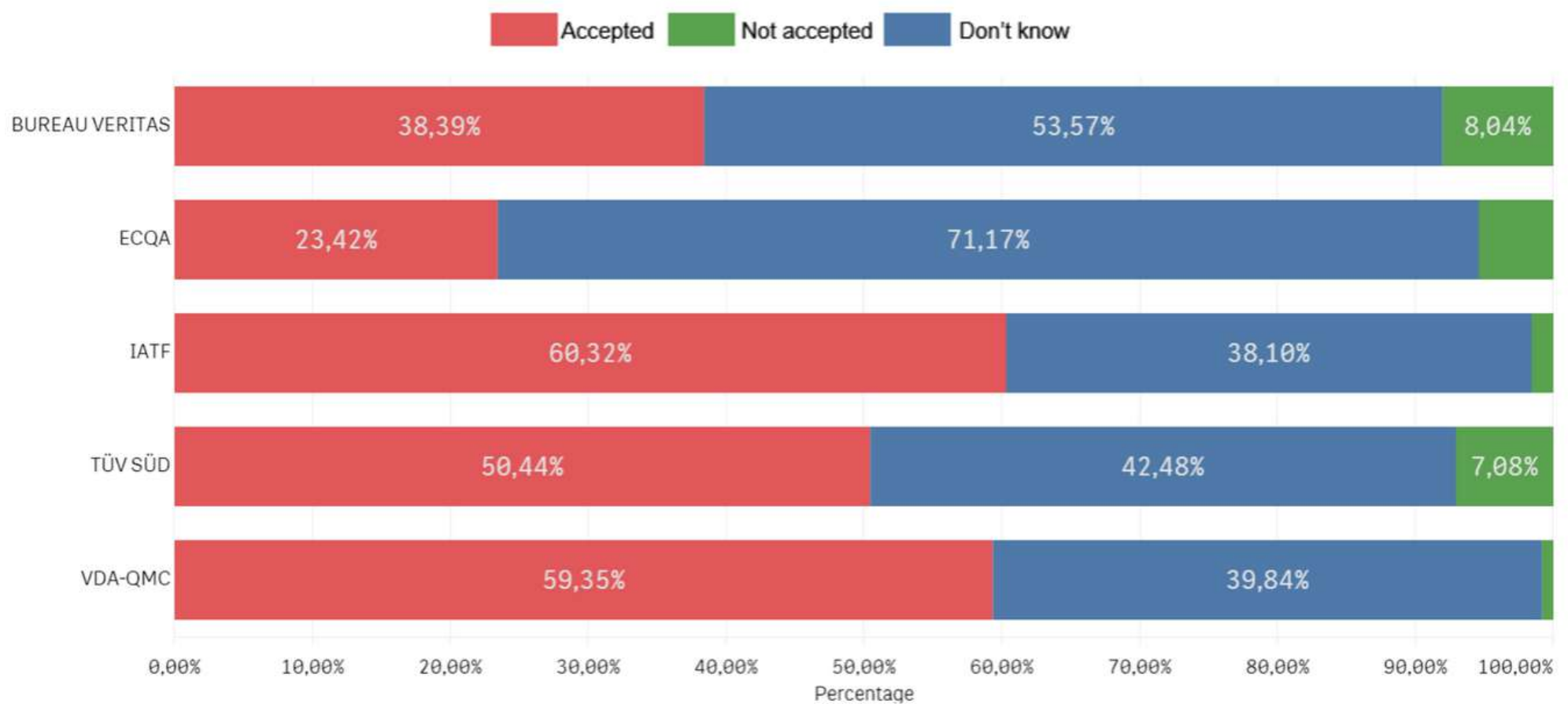
- The top ranking of recognised skill standards in the automotive sector are IAFT, VDA-QMC and TUV-SUD.
- The least known or recognised are Bureau Veritas and ECQA. Nevertheless, SMEs give high relevance to Bureau Veritas.
- Sectoral associations identify VDA-QMC and IAFT but underline the importance of ECQA as recognition standard.
