## SUSTAINABILITY MANAGER



Automotive manufacturers and suppliers are expected to pursue effective environmental throughout the life-cycle of the product in order to reduce the environmental footprint.

All products manufactured within automotive sector, and the applied materials and substances used in the process are expected to meet environmental standards for design, development, distribution, use, disposal or recycling.



A Sustainability Manager works on developing and implementing a sustainability strategy for the company. The task generally resembles the work of an internal auditor, analysing sustainability issues independently within the company and introducing waste and waste minimization practices.



In terms of qualifications a Sustainability Manager can come from different professional environments, with the advantage of technical education associated with communication and management skills. These managers need to be continuously trained (a sustainability management certification program) and follow developments in legislation, environmental technologies and waste reduction.
